








With the season drawing to a close, it's time to go out and slay some clays. Here are some top places to do it - whether you want to learn to shoot clays or improve your technique

Shooting in Yorkshire

Bisley & Braidwood, Surrey & Scotland

The famous Bisley has two shooting grounds in the UK. There is the shooting ground in 3,000 acres of Surrey heath and woodland just outside London, and the Braidwood ground just south of Edinburgh.

There are two different shooting grounds on the Surrey campus; Cottesloe Heath caters for individuals or groups with an instructor and Long Siberia offers automated pay & play for experienced shots. Cottesloe Heath benefits from the 1865 Victorian Clubhouse, and one of the highest clay towers in the country. There is also an exhilarating grouse layout with a line of well-established butts. Long Siberia offers the experienced shot 23 automated stands to take themselves round without an instructor.

Meanwhile, Bisley at Braidwood is located on a stunning estate overlooking the Eildon Hills in the Scottish Borders just south of Edinburgh.
